The Tell Tale Hearts, "The Tell Tale Hearts" (Vox) — Like many of the best original garage-rock wonders — including the Leaves, Remains, Standells and Blues Magoos — this San Diego quintet plays music that is hard-tempered and expansive without ever seeming precious or compromised. In particular, their breakneck blues-rock has a nice leering, threatening feel to it that places this debut LP among the more substantial extended works of this young genre. Better yet, the band is even tougher and snappier on stage — a living testament to the durability of the rave-up tradition.
